Time Allotted: 15-20 minutes

Area: Cafeteria

Materials Needed: lunchbox

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Listen and follow directions	Stand in line quietly	Eat your own food
Know your food choices	Raise your hand for help	Use table manners
Get what you need before sitting down	Stay in your seat	Soft voices

Objective: Students will be able to follow cafeteria directions, getting the items needed before sitting down to

Discuss and Model Positive Examples:

- Listen and follow directions
- Remain silent when walking. Whisper while waiting
- Line basics (face forward, hands to your side, and watch where you are going).
- Raise your hand for help.
- After getting food and necessary items (sauce, dressing, silverware), remain seated.

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Walking side by side
- Standing up at your seat.
- Hanging on the back of the person in front of you
- Throwing items such as lunchbox, food or other items
- Getting up to retrieve items you may have forgotten (raise your hand first).
- Yelling across the lunchroom or table.

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Time Allotted: 15-20 minutes

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Materials Needed: backpack/lunchbox

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Face Forward	Keep stuff still	Keep your hands to yourself
Single File	Walk everywhere	Whisper when waiting
Walk on the right	2	Silent when walking

Objective: Students will be able to walk through the hallways safely without disturbing other students.

Discuss and Model Positive Examples:

- Walk in a single file on the right side of the hallway using markers
- Remain silent when walking. Whisper while waiting.
- Line basics (face forward, hands to your side, and watch where you are going).
- Go directly to your destination

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Walking side by side
- Walking on the left side of the hall way.
- Hanging on the back of the person in front of you.
- Slinging items such as backpack or lunchbox
- Laying on the wall or putting your hands all over the wall.
- Talking to others using a voice that is not a whisper
- Skipping down the hall
- · Walking down the hall backwards

Area: Playground

Materials Needed: Equipment

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Follow safety rules	Use equipment properly	Take turns

Students will be able to play on the playground safely without hurting other students.

Discuss and Model Positive Examples:

- Show proper use of swings/slides and equipment.
- Provide instructions. Practice following instructions
- Walk around playground and point to areas available to play.
- · Role play taking turns, including others, playing fair, being a good sport
- Practice lining up at designated spot. Bringing equipment to designated spot.

Going to areas that are prohibited

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Leaving equipment on playground
- Staying on playground.
- Not following instructions.
- Twisting/sideways swinging.
- Walking up slides.
- Fussing/fighting/bad sport

Check for Understanding

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Area: Restroom

Time Allotted: 15-20 minutes

Materials Needed: book/folder

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Hush	Flush	Use bathroom manners
Promptly enter and exit	Wash	Wait your turn
Pay attention		Keep your hands and feet to yourself

Students will be able to use restrooms safely and efficiently without disturbing other students.

Discuss and Model Positive Examples:

- Wait quietly in line to enter restroom. Before entering, place any items outside the restroom.
- Walk into restroom and watch where you are going.
- Bathroom manners(use toilet, flush, wash hands-one push, dry hands-three pushes/throw trash in can)
- Leave restroom when finished. Go to designated spot or to classroom.

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Running/sliding/pushing/shoving.
- Jumping on walls/hanging on stalls.
- Leaving stalls locked.
- Writing on walls.
- Staying in bathroom to talk/play.
- Leaving water running/toilet not flushed
- Yelling/loud voice
- Using too much soap/paper towels
- Throwing towels on floor/playing basketball toss

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Time Allotted: 15-20 minutes

Area: Bus Area

Materials Needed: backpack/lunchbox

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Be packed and stay packed	Stay in proper area	Obey Hall Monitors
	Keep area clean	Obey Late Bus Monitor/s

(remaining packed) while obeying authority figures Objective: Students will be able to follow bus departure directions, being prepared with all materials packed

Discuss and Model Positive Examples:

- Listen for directions from Hall or Late Bus Monitors.
- Line basics (face forward, hands to your side, and watch where you are going).
- Touching or hanging on the back of the person in front of you.
- Remember to use soft voices when talking
- Remain with your class at all times until dismissal.

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Walking side by side
- Running
- Hanging on the back of the person in front of you.
- Unpacking your items
- Playing in the dirt
- Yelling

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Time Allotted: 15-20 minutes

Area: Media Center

Materials Needed: Library Books

Review Expectations:

Ready	Responsible	Respectful
Have your books with you	Put books back in proper place	Respect quiet zones
Know your library number	Be quick and quiet	Keep hands to yourself

Discuss and Model Positive Examples: Students will be able to search for and check out library books without disturbing other students.

Look for books quietly

- Respect others looking for books
- Line up quietly at check-out station
- Go directly to your class after checking out books
- Properly place books back on shelf when looking
- Return books to proper place (drop box for books)

Discuss and Model Negative Examples:

- Running in library
- Grouping together to talk instead of looking for books
- Scattering books and throwing books down on shelf
- Messing with displays in library
- Skipping people in check-out line
- Talking to others using a voice that is not a whisper.

- Talking to your neighbor

- Using materials inappropriately
